The Gandhi Media Foundation in association with Gandhian organizations and other agencies working to promote peace and harmony, proposes to organise a Gandhi Short Film Competition for school and college students. What is expected from each entry is the artistic presentation of Gandhi’s life, work, philosophy and their impact on society.

**Last Date of receipt of entries: 30th August 2013.**

## Details:

1. The duration of the films should be from 5 minutes to 15 minutes.
2. The entries should be in DVD format.
3. The entries should be sent to the Gandhi Media Foundation duly certified as original by head of the school /College (including Parallel College) along with an entry fee of Rs 200 (DD drawn in favor of Gandhi Media Foundation)
4. A three member Jury will constitute the selection committee.
5. The award winning entries (1st and 2nd of both categories) and a few other films which the Jury will identify as outstanding will be screened at Trivandrum from 2nd October 2013 for 5 days in a **Gandhi short film festival**
6. The Award winning entries and a few other films will also be screened on 2nd October 2013 at all district headquarters in Kerala. Efforts are also being made to screen these films at places outside Kerala such as Madurai, Chennai, Bangalore, Hyderabad, Bombay, Jaipur, Ahmadabad, Belgaum, Calcutta, Delhi etc.
7. Films Can be either in Malayalam, Tamil, Hindi and English. Films in other Indian languages should carry subtitles in English.
8. Plans are also afoot to screen a few of these films in selected schools in Kerala and outside with the co-operation of the schools and colleges.
9. The decision of the Jury shall be final.
10. Any dispute leading to legal proceedings, if any, will be limited to the courts in Trivandrum.
